

## **VIVATERRA Care Instructions:** Hydrangea Wreath – Green or Red

Introducing our ingenious and seasonally stunning alternative to poinsettias: a hydrangea wreath on a grapevine base. Our floral designer grows his own hydrangeas by the ocean, then sun-bleaches the cut flowers and enhances them with food coloring. Glycerin keeps the petals pliable and adds a soft radiance to the wreath. Whether used as a centerpiece or hung on a wall or door, we suspect you'll want to save and store it for seasons to come.



### **Care Instructions:**

**Light:** Keep away from direct and bright light.

Preserved wreaths have been handcrafted of natural botanicals that have been preserved with glycerin and a dye to develop the color of the finished product. The glycerin replaced the water in the plant material and makes the finished product soft and pliable and if displayed inside, out of direct sunlight, will look presentable much longer than dried materials and can last for years.

If your hydrangea wreath becomes wet, it may “bleed” the color on nearby furnishings. Under most normal household conditions this is not a problem. We do not recommend that preserved wreaths be displayed on exterior doors where they may get wet from rain.

If your hydrangea wreath gets dusty, gently clean it with a soft brush or a hair dryer set on the lowest setting.

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
